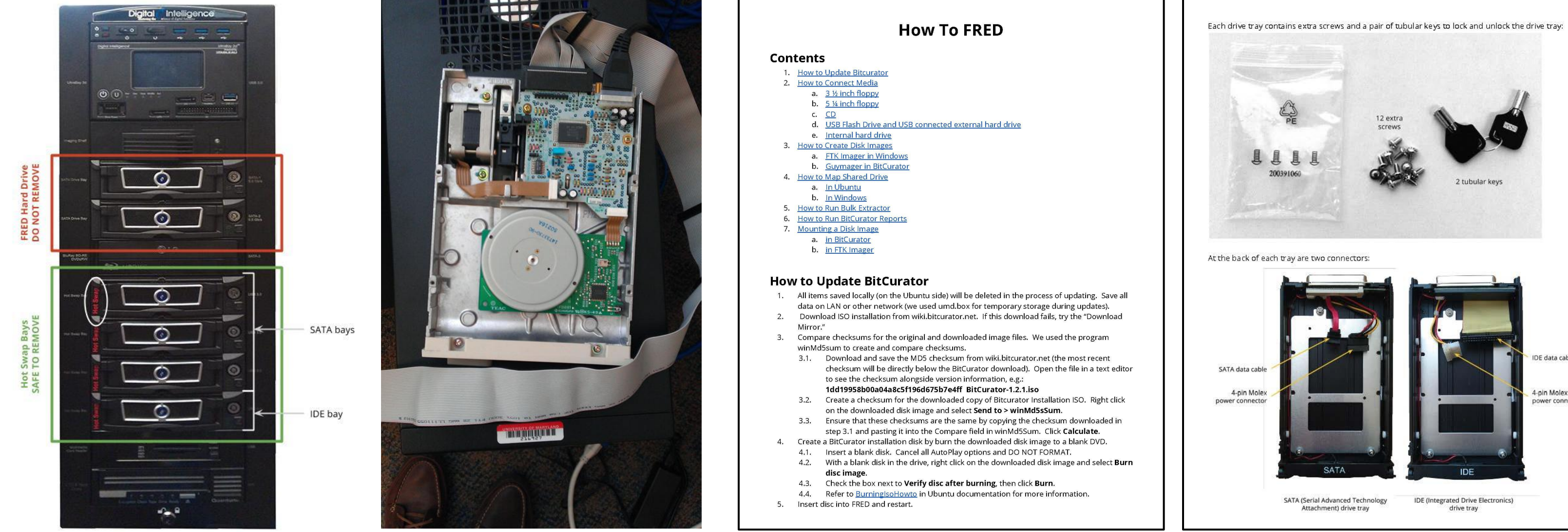

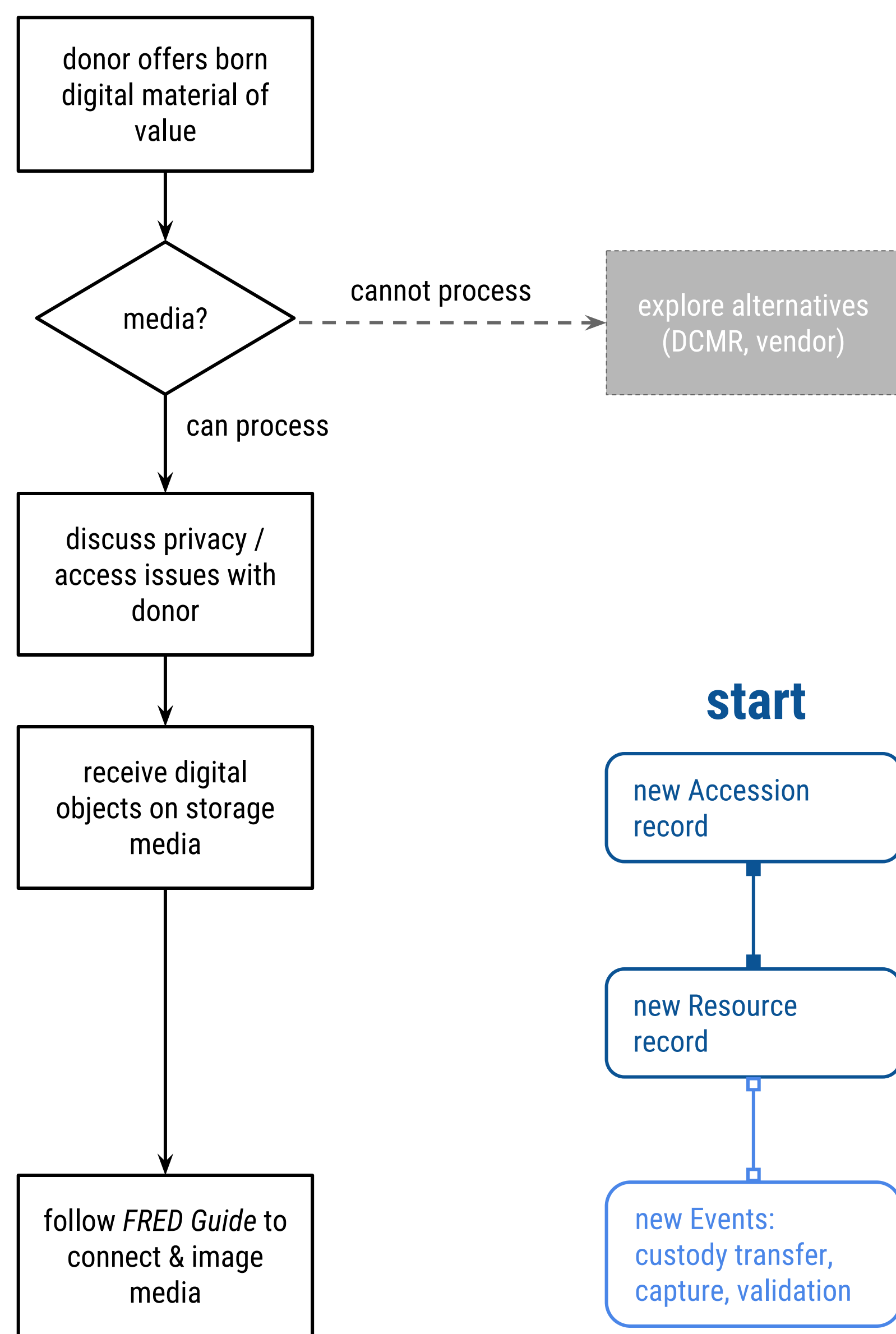

next steps

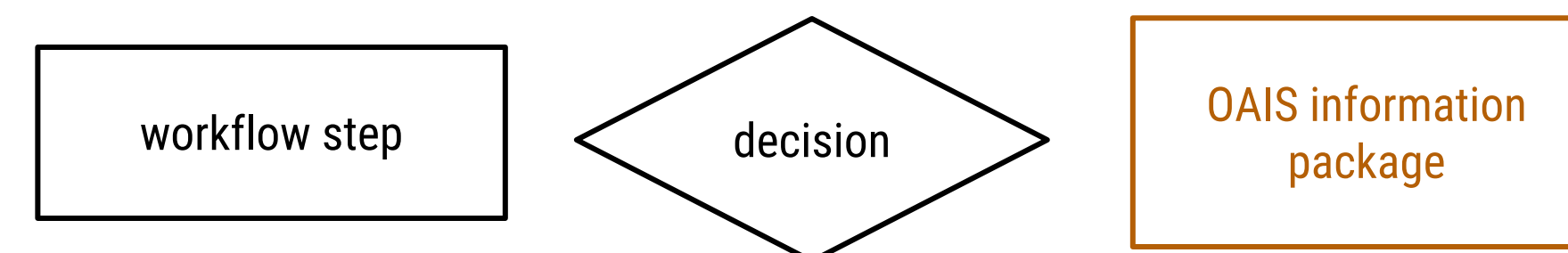
- **Test & refine** process National Labor College (AFL-CIO) electronic records
