This concerns the University of Maryland (hereinafter referred to as "Publisher") Thesis and Dissertation Electronic Publication Form representing your terms and conditions for publication of the PhD Thesis (referred to herein as the "Work") of Derek Liechty of NASA Langley Research Center. We regret that Dr. Liechty is prevented by U.S. Government regulations from executing said Thesis and Dissertation Electronic Publication Form. This letter is provided in lieu of the Thesis and Dissertation Electronic Publication Form and we trust that it will suffice to permit publication of the Work to take place.

Inasmuch as the Work is authored by Dr. Liechty as part of his official duties as a U.S. Government employee, U.S. copyright protection does not attach to the Work (17 U.S.C. § 105). The U.S. Government is the owner of foreign copyrights in the Work. U.S. Government works may be used by members of the U.S. public without copyright restrictions. Please be aware of the notice requirements of 17 U.S.C. 403 for publications incorporating a U.S. Government work. The U.S. Government retains the right to use, reproduce, distribute, create derivative works, perform and display the Work (such retained rights referred to herein as "U.S. GOVERNMENT RIGHTS").

Subject to the aforementioned reservation of U.S. GOVERNMENT RIGHTS, Publisher is granted permission to reproduce, publish, and distribute the Work in any form, language, or manner, now or hereafter known or developed, throughout the world, and to authorize others to do so on its behalf. This permission includes placing the Work in the Digital Repository at the University of Maryland (DRUM).

In accordance with Title 18 of the United States Code §209, U.S. Government employees may not accept compensation for their government service from any source other than the U.S. Government. Thus, Dr. Liechty may not accept any royalties resulting from publication of the Work or arising from the aforementioned permissions granted to Publisher.

Dr. Liechty has represented to NASA that, to the best of his knowledge, he is the original author of the Work; his contribution to the Work does not infringe upon any existing copyright, proprietary right, or other right of a third party; and all clearance permissions, if necessary, to use materials of third parties have been obtained. This letter and the permission granted herein are subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The Work shall not be used in any manner that would suggest or imply endorsement by NASA or any NASA employee of any commercial product, service or activity;
- 2. Publication by Publisher in no way limits U.S. GOVERNMENT RIGHTS in the Work:
