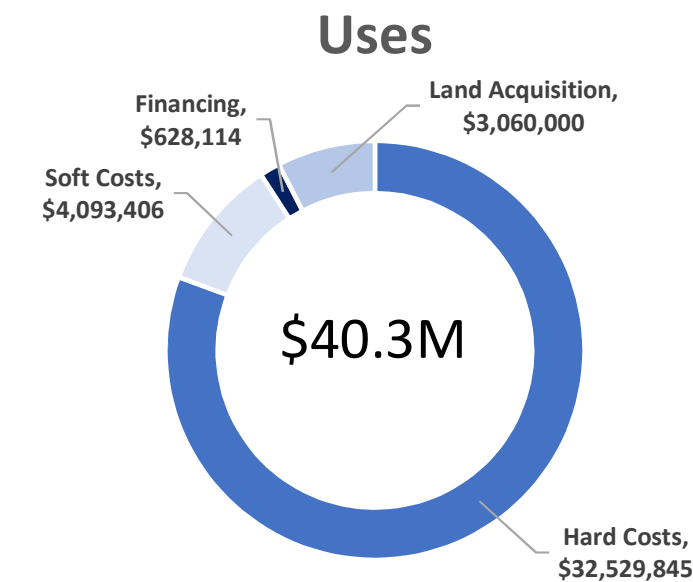
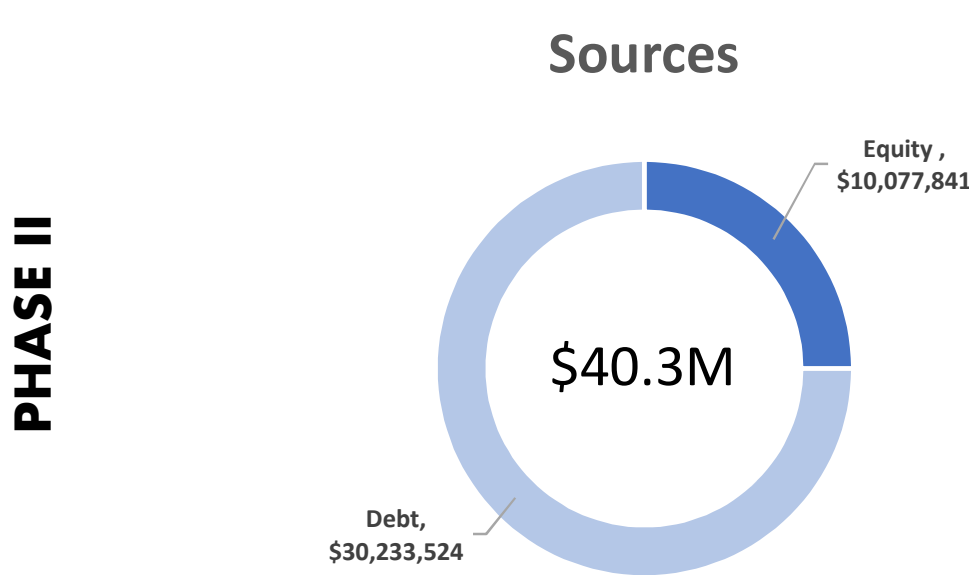
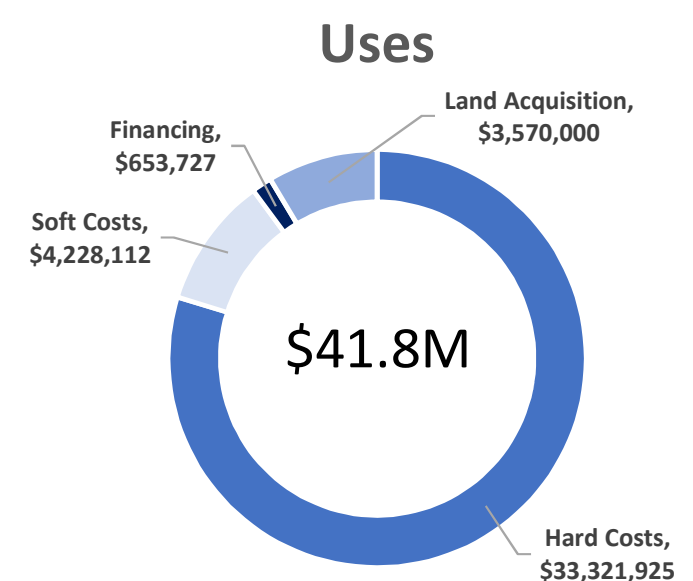
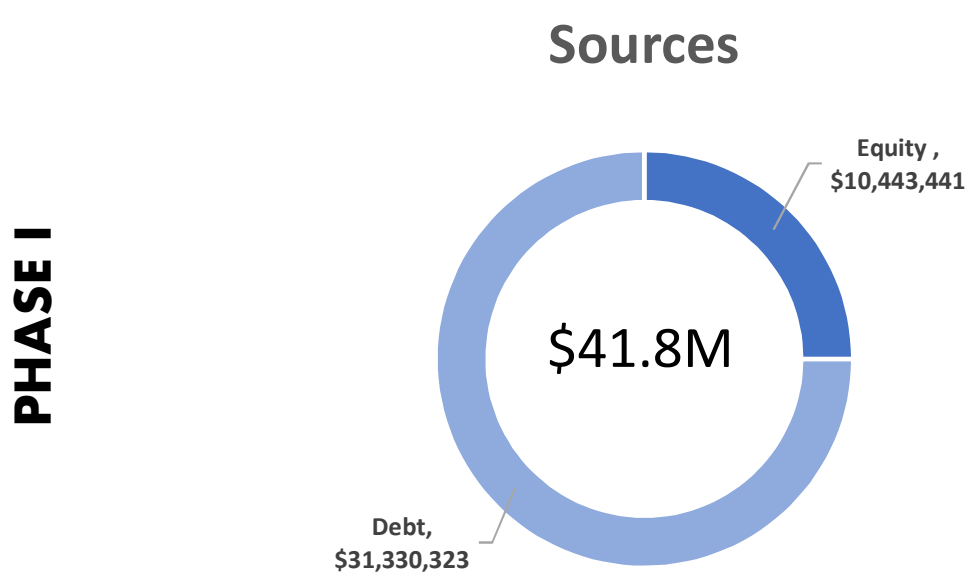
POPULATION MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD SIZE MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME
