



Work, school, social group, housing area


Habitus

Capital(Individual)Fields(Group)Doxa(Expectations)

Doxa

Rules of a group, values, standards, normative behaviour

[(Habitus)(Capital)] + Field=Practice





Shared language between Capital and Field through the translation of Doxa
