


The First World War Letters of H.J.C. Peirs

- Family requested that everything be digitized and made freely available without copyright restrictions



Welcome to the First World War Letters of H.J.C. Peirs, a digital history project at Gettysburg College.


lack Peirs was a British officer in the 8th Battalion, The Oueen's (Royal West Surrey) Regiment. For three years, Peirs served on the western front, fighting in every major campaign waged by the British Army from 1915 to 1918. During the war, Peirs rose in rank from Lieutenant to Lieutenant-Colonel and he was decorated with Distinguished Service Order (two bars) and named a Companion of the Order of St. Michael and St. George at the King's Birthday Honours in 1919.




Mapping the Great War (Then)



Mapping the Great War (Now)


