METHODOLOGY

The survey was designed and analyzed by the Program on International Policy Attitudes for WorldPublicOpinion.org. Field work was conducted through C-Voter in India. Face-to-face interviews were conducted among a stratified national random sample of 1,452 Indian adults 18 years and older. All geographical regions were sampled, with the exception of the extreme northeast (3% of India's area, 2% of its population). The data were weighted for gender, educational level, and religious group.
