INTENTIONAL VS. NON-PURPOSE-BUILT

- *"Archival Storage" (Harvard Model):
 PI = 100-280 years
- "Annex Storage" (non-purpose-built):PI = 10-58 years

PRESERVATION-RELATED REASONS FOR OFF-SITE STORAGE

- Disaster back-up
- Climate control
 - Specialized environments
- Space is a preservation consideration as well
 - Collections on-site
 - Enclosures
 - Oversized
- Tiered preservation considerations
